Ironically, this model is also rated as one of the best commercial backpack leaf blower models on the market. With a 63cc engine putting out 3.7 horsepower, this blower offers excellent power in an ergonomic, reliable package, and is the most powerful backpack leaf blower we've reviewed Specs 63cc 2-stroke engine 3.7 horsepower 920 CFM airflow rating 230 MPH max airspeed Industry Leading - 5-year warranty Our Take Away If you've never heard of the Schroeder Group, your not alone. Schroeder has, however, been around a long time, in fact since 1949. The Schroeder Group a German manufacturer, specializing in modern machine equipment. While it comes in a close second to the Husqvarna 350BT, this Schroeder blower is a powerhouse blower that will hold up to intensive use. For larger yards or those with significant hills, the considerable power of this model will undoubtedly be useful. If you're relatively new to 2-stroke engines (mixing gas and oil), be sure to follow the manufacturer mix-ratio closely, since the Poulan blower seems particularly sensitive to improper gas/oil ratios. And if you're looking for one of the best cheap backpack blowers on the market - this is one to consider. Courtesy of a 79.9cc engine, with an astounding 1071 CFM airflow rating, this blower can easily tackle jobs well out of the reach of most other leaf blowers. Though the best model varies based on your personal needs, the best Gas-powered backpack blower we recommend is the Husqvarna 350BT. This model offers, in our opinion, the best combination of power, versatility, and dependability for the widest range of uses. If you're more interested in a Battery-Powered Backpack blower we recommend either the EGO Power + or Greenworks 80V battery-powered backpack leaf blowers. How Do You Start a Backpack Leaf Blower? The method to start a Gas-powered backpack blower is very similar to starting a handheld blower. Watch how to start both types of backpack blowers in the videos below: This is how to start a Gas-powered backpack leaf blower: Carefully set the backpack blower upright - on the ground. Turn the carburetor (push bulb - 3-4 times) If the backpack blower is cold, close the choke Pull the starter cord (unless of course, it's an electric start) Once it's running, open the choke, and you're ready to blow. This is how to start a Battery-powered Backpack Leaf Blower: Insert a fully charged lithium-ion battery Turn the switch to "On" Adjust the speed trigger, and you're ready to blow. Can you Vacuum Leaves with a Backpack Blower? Backpack blowers are designed for one thing - to move leaves and debris as quickly as possible, all while taking the strain out of that chore. If you're interested in a leaf blower that also includes a vacuum - check out our reviews for the Best Leaf Vacuum, Mulcher, Blowers. How Do You Use a Backpack Leaf Blower? The operation of backpack blowers varies somewhat with each model; however, these are the standard features found on most backpack blowers: Comfortable-easy to wear harnesses Trigger mounted speed control located on the blower tube Massive CFM power (cubic feet per minute) Point and blow debris with enormous wind speed Are Backpack Leaf Blowers Noisy? Yes, though, battery-operated blowers are quite a bit quieter than their gas counterparts. As with most other power tools, hearing protection is recommended when using gas leaf blowers, especially more powerful models like the Husqvarna 350BT. Are Backpack Leaf Blowers More Powerful Than Handheld? Generally speaking, yes. For example, the Husqvarna 350BT moves up to 692 cubic feet of air per minute. Compare this with the handheld 125 V+BVX leaf blower - rated at 495 CFM, and you'll see a typical power gap between backpack blowers and handheld leaf blowers. Are battery-powered or gas-powered backpack blowers better? While both gas and battery-powered blowers serve the same function, gas blowers are typically more powerful. For instance, the Schroeder gas blower with 920 CFM is much more powerful than EGO's battery blower at 600 CFM. However, that limited amount of extra gas power may not be as important to some people, as the convenience of a plug-and-go, battery-operated blower. Wrapping Up: Based on our extensive reviews, we find the Husqvarna 350BT, Schroeder, and Poulan Pro PR48BT to be the best backpack leaf blowers on the market today. Of course, our reviews include what we think are the best blowers for the most significant number of customers. Depending on your own needs and budget, you may prefer one of the other excellent backpack blowers listed in our reviews above.
